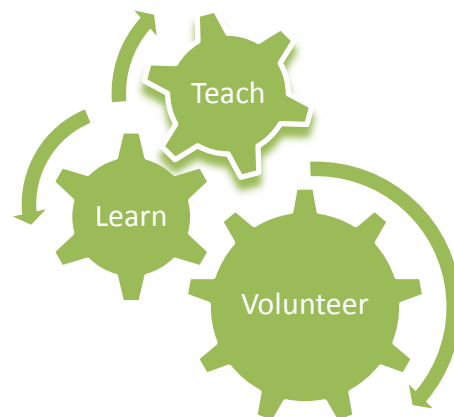




Information Session

Scratch is a new programming language that makes it easy to create interactive stories, animations, games, music, and art. Young people learn important mathematical and computational ideas, while also learning to think creatively, reason systematically, and work collaboratively.

Lego Robotics

Lego Robotics is a fun, educational, and creative activity that tests students' construction, programming, and design skills while teaching basic concepts of engineering and technology.

Gamestar Mechanic

Students learn guiding principles of game design in an exciting, creative environment.
