Self-nominations (volunteers) are encouraged. Web-based voting will be held soon after that Thursday after nominees agree to be on the ballot. Please note that

1. Positions may be left vacant if there is no validly elected representative.
2. If a representative must resign, the student receiving the next highest number of votes shall replace that student.
3. Ties are resolved by choice of the CSE Chair.
4. Student constituency is defined by the Registrar of MSU.
5. Overall election is valid if and only if 10% participation is shown in the voting (10% of majors vote).
6. Elected representatives will enter the pool of candidates whom may be asked to serve on the Department Hearing Board, Teach Award committee, College Committees, etc.
